

THE CANADIAN FLOWERS FOR FOOD SOCIETY

SOCIETY ACT

CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the society is Canadian Flowers for Food Society.
2. The purpose of the society is:
 - A. To relieve poverty by collecting discarded flowers from major flower growers and distributors and delivering these flowers:
 - o to homeless persons, who in turn exchange them for monetary donations on the streets;
 - o to "qualified donees" as defined in the Income Tax Act, for use in their "flowers for food" exchange programs.
 - B. To protect and preserve the environment by diverting floral (organic) waste from landfills to composting stations.
 - C. To provide life skills training to homeless people while allowing them to earn a living by:
 - o teaching participants to create floral arrangements; and
 - o training and providing homeless persons with jobs producing viable compost.
